Most recently my work deals with the idea of serendipity and the search for a happy medium between analogue and digital. I'm creating works that tend to do the opposite of everyday life. First, creating them in a digital form through editing and only later having them become an object, that inhabits our living space. The results are paintings that leave the viewers questioning how it is created.

The starting point of an idea of this particular painting was an oil spill in the puddle - shiny rainbowish reflection called light interference. While digging deeper in this topic to see where to go from there - my imagination was filling up with colours and shapes which were reflecting about the topic... until I saw a picture taken from a pond, zoomed in thousand times via microscope - then I knew - I have to try it out as well.

As my object of interest is found on a wet surface only, I collected samples of the puddles and revealed the life of invisible scale. So the gestures, the shapes and movement are taken from my discoveries but colour inspired by physics.
